Maintenance Supervisor Report

- ➤ Delinquent List Ten delinquent residents this month in the sum of \$3,937.39. Account # 275, 450, 469 & 498 have had liens applied to property. Account # 308 & 401 have been shut off. Account # 185, 439, 494 & 539 are past due.
- Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard reported to the board that the estimated cost for seal coating all the roads in Matherville, 50,000 sq. feet, would be \$75,000. Trustee Jeff Garrett asked if he had checked the price of slurry and Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard replied that yes he had and slurry would be double the cost. No one currently will guarantee the price quote for seal coating the roads. Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard recommended to the board not to seal coat the dead end road in the Village for cost cutting reasons. The board asked Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard to get the paperwork started for seal coating the roads.
- Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard will be out February 17th thru February 19th to an Annual Conference in Effingham.
- ➤ Maintenance Supervisor Dave Maynard report that 25 tons of salt at \$180 per ton has been delivered.
